

WI DeafBlind Census Facts as of December 1, 2009




- 202 Students reported
- 116 males and 86 females
- 201 Caucasian (79%) and 53 (21%) Minority
- 2% of students are in Early Childhood (Birth – 2 years old)
- 5% of students have **DeafBlindness** as their primary disability
- 52 students exited the census (graduated, moved, passed away or no longer DeafBlind)




